We have continued to improve the Dog Salmon River Lodge, and it remains one of the only lodges in Alaska where you can walk from camp and shoot a 60" moose, or a 10' brown bear and sleep in cabins with heaters and electric lights. At the lodge we have a main cabin, two client cabins, a guide's bunkhouse, shower house, storage building and a meat and skinning shed/shop and two weatherports. We also have satellite phone service at the lodge and at each spike camp. Fishing is always great in the fall with Silver Salmon, Dolly Varden Trout and Arctic Char caught right at the lodge.

Our hunting area is approximately 550 square miles (over 352,000 acres) in size. With an area this large we utilize up to 12 spike camps, located throughout the entire area. With over 120 miles of coastline, and 24 salmon streams, there are many great areas to hunt in this concession.

This season was the 33rd year that I have owned, operated the Dog Salmon River Lodge and hunted this area. Thanks again to all of you who arrived as strangers and went away as friends, after sharing experiences that will never be forgotten.

Alaska Peninsula - Dog Salmon River Lodge

After losing the 2020 season due to covid, it was good to get back to camp in May. Rick Reynolds, Riley Pitts and Luke Miller hauled many loads of guides, clients and supplies into the base camp. All spike camps were in place, guides and clients were ready to hunt on May 10th, opening day.

Howard Goldey the APHA raffle winner was first to score on May 12th, Michael Futch took his bear on the 14th, Chris Parker took his bear on the 16th, Eric Vaillancourt and George Sweirkos took their bears on the 17th, Michael Bartsch on the 18th, Joey Binnion took his big bear on the 22nd, Eric Vaillancourt took two wolves, along with Marty Binnion taking one.

On September 12th, Chris Moore the camp manager and Jack Egan, the chef, flew directly to Pilot Point on a King Air Flight with Dena'ina Air Taxi with 2800#'s of food and supplies. Rick started hauling people and supplies to camp. Ryan Enyeart finished mowing the runway.

On September 13th, we took another King Air Flight to Pilot Point, with another 2800#'s of supplies and guides. Rick Reynolds flew us into base camp, once the weather cleared. The weatherport tents were set up and supplies were stored. Mike Lego and Ron Geyer were back to hunt moose and wolves on September 15th, after taking two brown bears on a previous hunt. Rick hauled more loads of food and freight in his Cessna 180.

Ron took a 58" bull on the 18th from the main camp. The meat, horns and cape were packed 1/2 mile back to the meat house. Mike took a record book 68" bull on the 22nd, right behind the lodge.

Riley Pitts and Rob Wing arrived with two more super cubs, to fly for the bear season. Bear guides and clients arrived, and we flew them to spike camps, for the season opener of October 7th.

The six bear hunters all took nice bears. Ken Schmidt took his bear on the 9th, Chris Miller got his bow kill bear on the 12th, Brandon Smith and Josh Sexton got their bears on the 13th, Chris Morgan got his bear on the 15th, and Kelby McCoy on the 19th. (...Continued on Page 4 / Back Page)
