

Alaska Peninsula - Dog Salmon River Lodge

On May 2nd Dee and Riley flew to the main camp. The crew after being stuck in King Salmon for 2 days due to weather, arrived to open up the lodge for the spring season. We were now behind 2 days in camp preparation, but with the same crew for the past 8 years, everyone knew what to do, and camp was ready for the clients on May 8th. Rob, our 3rd pilot arrived and we were ready to haul supplies.

Five of our clients arrived in Pilot Point, but without their baggage. That evening the baggage arrived in Pilot Point, and everything made it to the lodge. Rifles were checked and everyone was ready to fly to spike camps on the 9th, but the weather didn't cooperate, with winds up to 62mph.

Finally, everyone was out to the spike camps and ready to bear hunt. Bill Hill, back on his 3rd hunt, after his 2nd bear, took our first bear (9'4") at 10:15pm on the 13th. Dale Smith, back on his 3rd hunt took a monster (10'6", 28 1/16" skull) at 5:15pm, on the 14th. John Welling and his wife Carla took a (9'3", 25 13/16" skull) bear at 11pm on the 21st. Wyatt Wingrove took the largest bear, (10'5", 28 9/16" skull) at 10:30pm on the 22nd.

Matt Caldwell was back on his 10th hunt with AAA, took a monster (10'3", 27 11/16" skull) for his 3rd brown bear, on the 25th. Chip Wagner also took a (10', 26 12/16" skull) on the 25th. Greg Black, back after taking a 60" moose last fall, took a (9'4", 26 12/16" skull) bear on the 27th. Paul Sukalich took his bear on the 30th, along with a wolf. Mark Moore also took a wolf.

We have continued to improve the Dog Salmon River Lodge, and it remains one of the only lodges in Alaska where you can walk from camp and shoot a 60" moose, or a 10' brown bear and sleep in cabins with heaters and electric lights. At the lodge we have a main cabin, 2 client cabins, a guide's bunkhouse, shower house, storage building and a meat and skinning shed/shop and 2 weatherports. We also have satellite phone service at the lodge and each spike camp. Fishing is always great in the fall with Silver Salmon, Dolly Varden Trout and Artic Char caught right at the lodge.

Our hunting area is approximately 550 square miles (over 352,000 acres) in size. With an area this large we utilize up to 12 spike camps, located throughout the entire area. With over 120 miles of coastline and 24 salmon streams, there are many great areas to hunt in this concession.

This season was the 31st year that I have owned, operated the Dog Salmon River Lodge and hunted this area. Thanks again to all of you who arrived as strangers and went away as friends, after sharing experiences that will never be forgotten.
